- Submit a short written narrative telling us why you want to nominate your Direct Support Professional. Remember to give us personal details, specifically how they supported you through the Covid pandemic. This will help us to choose a winner.
- Provide a picture of your DSP. If possible, provide a picture of you and your DSP together.

Submit your nomination to Sharin@pbscommunityfoundation.org before October 1st.

Once we have reviewed all nominations we will contact you via email, no later than October 19th, to let you know if your nominee has won our Hero Award.
